Death and life confronted each other in a prodigious battle; the Prince of life who died, now lives and reigns. "Tell us, Mary, what did you see upon the way?" "I saw the sepulchre of the living Christ; I saw the glory of the Risen One. I saw the angels, his witnesses, the shroud and the garments. Christ, my Hope, is risen; he will go before his own into Galilee." We know that Christ is truly risen from the dead; O Victorious King, have mercy on us.
